Terms of Reference – Scientific Session Proposals**

Purpose

The Local Organizing Committee for the 18th Annual Meeting of the International Association of Therapeutic Drug Monitoring and Clinical Toxicology (IATDMCT) (Banff, Canada, 2020) supports the fundamentals of research and education as it relates to therapeutic drug monitoring (TDM) and clinical toxicology (CT) internationally.

Values

The work of the Local Organizing Committee shall reflect the values of IATDMCT:

- represent many different cultures and people.
- improve therapeutic management of patients and the practice of medicine worldwide.

Inclusiveness and broad participation are considered key to ensuring adherence to these principles and the success of the IATDMCT.

Expectations for Scientific Sessions

- Scientific Sessions will be evaluated on the basis of relevance/importance of the topic, equal distribution of TDM versus Clinical Toxicology topics (including environmental clinical toxicology), and quality of the proposal.
- Scientific Sessions will be evaluated on the basis of regional diversity.
 - List each speaker and the country of residence of each speaker.
- Scientific Sessions will be evaluated on the basis of gender diversity.
- Final decision for speakers and content rests with the Scientific Committee for the 2020 Congress.

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
